

VIEWPOINT AT PRESCOTT VALLEY WEST HOA BASKETBALL POLICY

K. Basketball Equipment:

1. No basketball backboards shall be installed without the prior approval of the ARC.
2. Basketball backboards shall not be installed structurally on a building or structure (they must be pole mounted).
3. Backboards must be professionally manufactured, of neutral color (clear, white, gray or tan) and free of brightly colored decals or graphics.
4. Poles and support brackets must be painted black or match the body color of the house.
5. All equipment including poles, support brackets and netting shall be maintained in good condition. Broken equipment, including backboards, bent poles, supports, rims and netting and peeled or chipped paint are prohibited. Netting is limited to nylon or similar cord netting; metal or other chain nets are prohibited.
6. The basketball pole must be set in the ground permanently and must be installed on the "interior" side of the driveway. Architectural approval request must include a site plan of the exact location of where the goal will be installed.
7. Spotlights or other lighting for the purpose of illuminating the area of play for use after sunset is prohibited.
8. The owner of the home is fully responsible for ball containment on their individual property. Painting of the driveway for a basketball court layout or any other similar purpose is prohibited.
9. Rear yard basketball backboard installations must conform to all of the above specifications.
10. Temporary basketball goals must be maintained in good condition and stored so as not to be visible from neighboring properties when not in use. Overnight storage of such equipment in a location visible from neighboring properties is prohibited.
